A Fresh Start

(John 21) A few days after Jesus resurrected from the dead, He was on the shore on the Sea of Galilee preparing a charcoal fire. He called out to Peter and several of the disciples who were fishing, "Friends, haven't you any fish?". They were out a long time but had not caught any fish and did not realize that it was the Lord asking. They were about to give up. Many times we're in similar circumstances in life (relationships, career, church) where we're about to give up due to the pressures surrounding us. A lot of times we get to those circumstances only because we've not been in line to the will and desire of God. We tend to be driven more by the pressures around us (what we want people to see in us) and make choices that best fit our desires and consider them to be from God.

Jesus then asked Peter and the disciples to cast their nets on the right side. Out of desperation, they did so and caught more than they could handle. Only then did they realize it was the Lord and His doing. Our Lord calls us out in our lowest and many times we ignore the call not realizing it is the Lord and miss out on the abundance of Grace that He has in store for us. Only because we're drowning in our problems. But just as the Lord gave a breakthrough to the fishermen when they listened to Him, He is willing to give you a breakthrough and a fresh start if you listen to His voice and obey.

Peter and the others had an amazing breakfast with the Lord that early morning, cooked by the Lord. Their lives were transformed by their encounters with Jesus. After the breakfast with Jesus, Peter was restored (forgiven) and given one of the greatest missions. Peter was given a fresh start!

From the encounter of Peter and the other disciples with Jesus, as well as many others, I believe there are three responses that lead to a fresh encounter and a fresh start with Jesus.

1) Surrender and repent: Recognize we have been created by God in His image and for His purpose, His Glory (1 Cor. 10:31; Isa. 43:7). It's very natural, in this world filled with pleasures and pressures of many kinds, we lose our focus and indulge in the desires of the flesh and lose track of the very purpose God has for us. Apostle Paul reminds us to do nothing with ungodliness and to train ourselves to be godly (1 Tim. 4:7).

Therefore, we need to surrender to God and ask for His strength to live out His purpose. Submit yourself, your challenges, your weakness, your pride to God, and then you'll be given the strength to resist the devil, who then will flee from you (James 4:7). Repent, so you may find mercy for a fresh start (Prov. 28:13)

2) Forgive and Forget: Apostle Paul wrote to the church in Philippi (Phil. 3:13-14) challenging both himself and the church to keep moving forward in the christian walk of faith. He reminds us to forget what lies behind and focus on what lies ahead - the goal that Christ Jesus has set for us.

Living in the past and not forgiving keeps us bound to sin. It's time that we stop looking back at past relationships, failures, temptations, things that are distracting us from being who Jesus wants us to be.

3) Trust and Obey: "Behold, I am doing a new thing; note it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert" (Isaiah 43:19).

Leaving our past behind is not easy, but our Lord promises to make our paths straight if we trust Him and submit our ways to Him (Prov. 3:5-6). Jesus taught us not to worry about tomorrow or our future but instead to seek first His Kingdom and all the things we worry about will be taken care of (Mat. 6:33).
